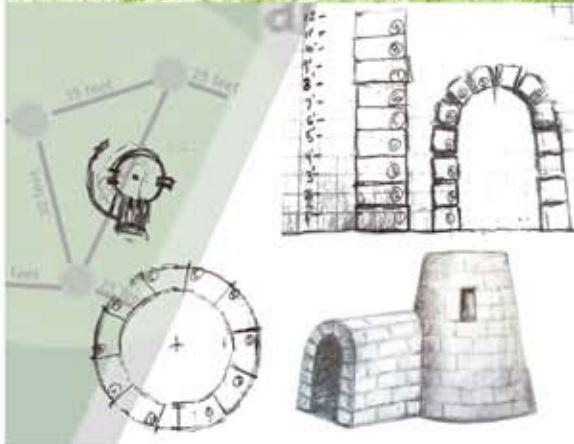


Sustainable Straw Bale Construction Workshop

In conjunction with the exhibition in the Gallery, on Saturday, September 29th, artist Brad McCombs will be on campus to lead an outdoor workshop on Straw Bale Construction. Brad has designed an outdoor sculpture for our campus to be created during the workshop and it will remain up for a month.

Discussion session is about possible uses of straw bales and other alternative architecture approaches. Discussions will revolve around material choices (wood, straw, rammed earth, metal, glass, concrete), their sustainability, and their impact on local and global ecology.
